Youth at Risk (YAR)

Jobs and Skills WA is the way the State Government, through the Department of Training and Workforce Development (DTWD), prioritises its investment in training to focus on courses that equip people to take up jobs that are, or will be, in high demand. Industry qualifications are also subsidised under Jobs and Skills WA, including general industry training courses and foundation skills and equity courses.



Communicare is offering the 22473VIC – Certificate II in General Education for Adults through the Jobs and Skills WA initiative. This qualification provides educational opportunities for school students to increase their participation in the community and workplaces.



Eligibility Criteria (Youth at Risk): Individuals must be between 15 to 25 years of age and referred by an Approved Referral agent. All individuals need to reside in Western Australia and must be unemployed.



Fees, the below fees outline a Tuition Fee outside of the Jobs and Skills Funding and is payable at enrolment for those that do not qualify for financial hardship.
